Big Brothers and Big Sisters/FOP

The Bigs in Blue Program is up and running, now we just need volunteers. You can volunteer in 2 ways:

1. Help out in one of the **School Based Monitoring** programs which is done strictly during school hours and on school property. Usually it involves one hour per week at a set time. Some of the programs involve helping a child with reading, homework, etc. Some are lunch programs where the mentor goes in and has lunch with his/her Little for 20 minutes and then goes out to play basketball, helps him/her with homework, or they just "hang out" with each other. These programs start in October and usually end in May. You would be surprised at the difference in these kids after receiving one-on-one attention from someone once a week for 6 to 7 months.
2. Volunteer for the **Community-Based** Program where you are matched with a child of an incarcerated parent (with the parent's permission) and you meet with your new found friend at least twice a month for 2 hours for the duration of the year. You choose whatever you wish to do... whether it is go to the movies, play sports, take a hike, or play video games. The one-on-one time is what is important.

If any of you are ready to get started now we can get the process going. If the background work can be done now, you will be ready in October to be matched with a Little in one of the schools. If the Community-Based Match is for you, we can get things going to get you matched ASAP.
